

Holiday Revue To Benefit "Operation Warmth"

(San Diego, CA-November 1, 1995) — Contributing a coat or blanket for the homeless will gain the donor admission to the musical revue "Come In From the Cold," to be presented by Blueprint Productions on Thursday-Saturday, December 7-9, at the North Clairemont United Methodist Church, 4570 Mt. Herbert, beginning at 7:00 p.m.

"Come In From the Cold," a funny yet poignant musical revue written by two-time Dove Award-winner Robert Sterling and Deborah Craig-Claar, features comedy sketches designed to enlighten while they entertain. The fast-paced show includes parodies of holiday situations, from shopping mall madness, overcommitted schedules and "Christmas-Season-Cough-n-Sneezin' Blues," to homelessness. The revue is interlaced with the voice of "Brent Busby" (played by Phil Worwa), a too-hip weatherman who keeps the audience updated on the coming cold snap.

The production is being presented by Blueprint Productions, a new performing arts ministry of North Clairemont United Methodist Church, as a feature of "Operation Warmth," a church outreach project to the homeless. Audience members are requested to bring a new or good used coat for a child, teen or adult or a warm blanket for admission to the show. Items collected will be distributed by two local agencies serving the local homeless population: San Diego Youth & Community Services' Storefront shelter for homeless youth and Christian Community Services.

The production is being directed by Rhonda Fleming, with choreography by Susan Stuber.

Seating will be limited for the three performances, and reservations are required. Call 278-2433. Tickets can be mailed or held at the door. A coat or blanket and a free ticket are required for admission. Refreshments will be available for purchase.
